Purpose: This <u>Core Competencies Workgroup</u> meeting was held to discuss and share feedback on the draft of a new prioritization tool based on a modified version of the <u>Core Competencies for Public Health Professionals</u> (Core Competencies), as well as a draft set of population health competencies developed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). In addition, this meeting provided an opportunity to update the Workgroup on the project related to the <u>Competencies for Performance Improvement Professionals in Public Health</u>.

Action: During the meeting:

- Workgroup members discussed the draft prioritization tool based on a modified version of the Core Competencies, including how the tool could be used in conjunction with the <u>Competency Assessments for Public Health Professionals</u>. Workgroup members were also asked to consider what additional tools or resources related to the Core Competencies might be useful to the public health community.
- Speakers from CDC engaged the Workgroup in discussion about a draft set of population health competencies developed by CDC to support their fellowship programs, including how these competencies relate to the Core Competencies and other sets of competencies.
- Workgroup members were updated on activities of the Core Competencies Workgroup's Subgroup on Performance Improvement Competencies.
