AIM STATEMENT


Engage statewide stakeholders through an action-oriented coalition to reduce the opioid problem

- Prevent addiction
- Increase recovery support
 counselors
- Improve healthcare access
- Increase substitutions and alternative treatments
- Decrease pharmaceutical industry advertising
- Increase overdose reversals
- Reduce stigma
