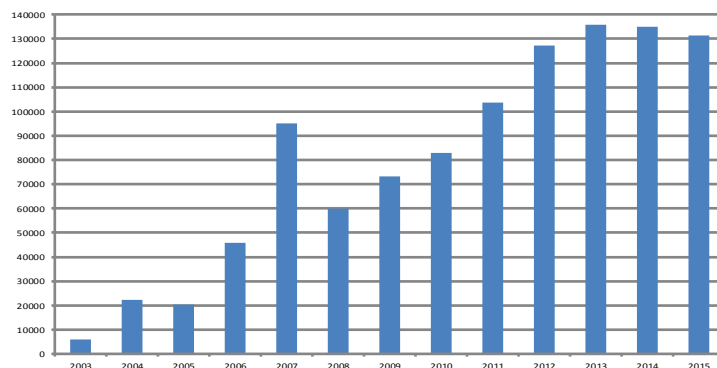

Returns on Investment

The **Kansas** Department of Health and Environment, partnered with the Department of Preventive Medicine and Public Health, University of Kansas School of Medicine-Wichita, conducted a study determining the cost savings for a public health learner taking online training through TRAIN as opposed to a classroom course.

Between 2005 and 2012, Kansas showed **\$14 million** in savings.

The **Kentucky** Department for Public Health documented savings in excess of **\$21.75 million** between 2007 and 2009.

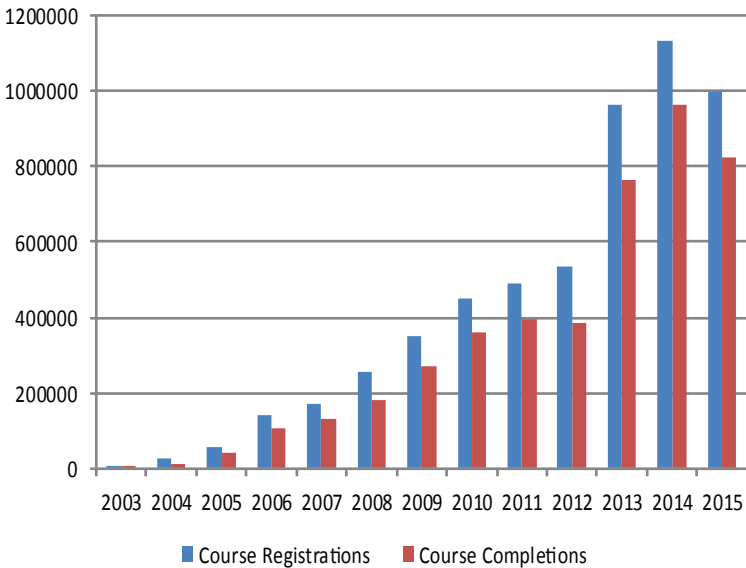

TRAIN Builds Competence

Over 4.4 million courses have been completed through TRAIN. Over 49% of courses completed included competencies, a figure that reflects 39% of all courses initially registered for.



A learner registers for a course every 32 sec.

For a total of over 5.6 million registrations

...and completes a course every 38 sec.

For a total of over 4.4 million completions

...49% of which include competencies.
